How to Apply for YSP Fellowship 2018

YSP 2018 will bring together approximately 100 talented PhD students, postdocs and assistant professors early in their careers from across the world who are involved in the field of biochemistry and molecular biology. YSP 2018 offers the opportunity to young scientists to share and exchange scientific experience, present their work to an international audience, meet internationally renowned professors, and thereby to promote their scientific future and career.

* **Date:** June 2- 4, 2018

* **Venue:** Chang Ki Won International Conference Hall, 7F, Library, Yonsei University, Seoul, Korea (50 Yonsei-ro, Seodaemun-gu, Seoul, 03722, Republic of Korea)

* **Participants must be:**

1. A member of an IUBMB-related National Society of Biochemistry and Molecular Biology, including national societies affiliated with regional federations namely FASBMB (Africa), PABMB (North & South America), FEBS (Europe) and FAOBMB (Asia & Oceania)
2. At one of the following stages in their career: (a) In the late stages of PhD training or (b) a postdoctoral fellow within 5 years of obtaining his/her PhD degree, or (c) an assistant professor (or similar academic rank) who has been appointed within 3 years.

Notes:

3. The YSP Fellowship includes full accommodation (in shared rooms), meals and travel grants during the YSP 2018 (*depending on Current Geographical Category of Applicant, that is whether the applicant is a resident overseas or in Korea*).

4. Each young scientist who is accepted to participate in the YSP in Seoul in 2018 must also register for and attend the IUBMB-FAOBMB International Congress of Biochemistry and Molecular Biology in Seoul, during 4-8 June 2018. The Registration fee for the Congress will be waived for YSP Fellowship winners.

5. A recipient of a fellowship from any previous IUBMB YSP or YSF event is **not** eligible for participation in the YSP in Seoul in 2018.

* **Key Dates**

- 18 February 2018: YSP Fellowship Application deadline.

(This deadline has been extended till 18 February)

- 8 March 2018: Winners of YSP Fellowships are to be announced.

Applicants should submit the completed Application Form plus the required attachments, all in one PDF file, to email (iubmb2018.ysp@gmail.com) by 18 February 2018.

Note: Lastname must be the Last name entered in Part 1 of the Application Form

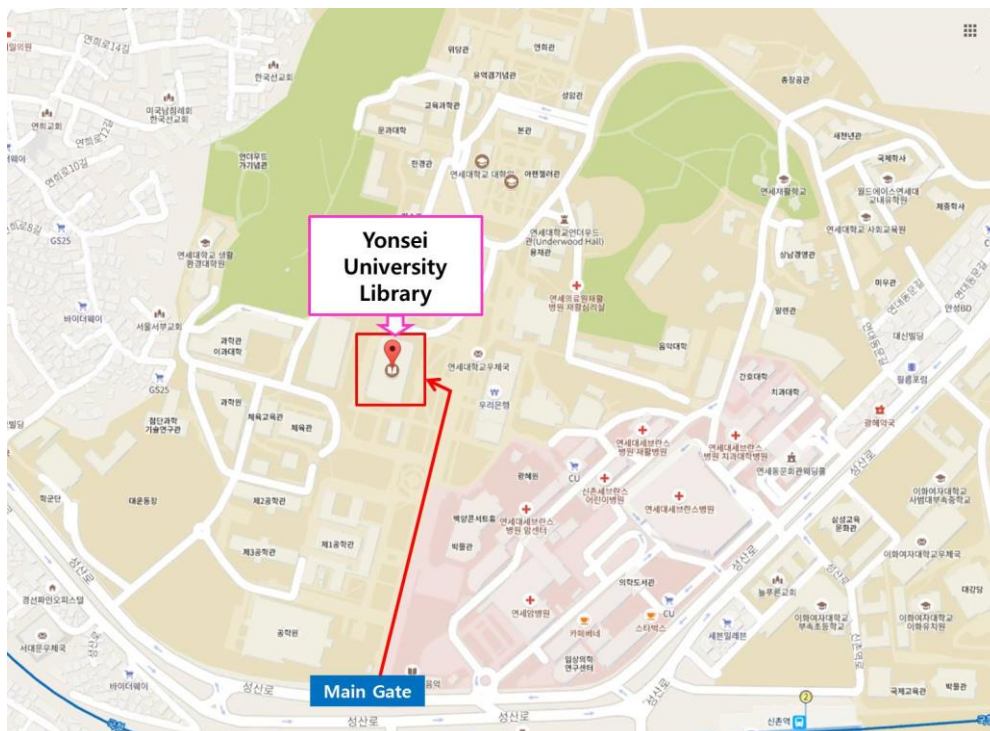
